

Aruba and the state of South Carolina have an agreement that allows students to attend Coastal Carolina University for the same tuition as South Carolina residents.

Benefits: In-State tuition gives Undergraduate Aruba students a total savings of \$14,244, and Graduate students \$8,188 per year.


Admissions Process

- 1 Online application at www.coastal.edu
- 2 Transcripts:
- Freshman Transfers Graduate
- 3 English Proficiency:

Toefl: 527 (pBT) OR 71 (iBT); IELTS: 6.0 with no sub-score lower than 5.0 OR ELS 112 certificate.

English Waiver: graduated from a high school located outside the United States of America in which the primary language of instruction is English and which is accredited by one of the regional U.S. accrediting bodies, AND I have BOTH a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 AND either a combined SAT score of 1000 in CR and Math (with a minimum of 500 in CR) OR an ACT composite score of 21.
